The goal of *D6 Family Ministry Journal* is to create a platform and a resource for students, colleges, universities, and practitioners interested in the academic implications and tools related to family ministry. We are currently accepting proposals for the Fifth Edition, which will be published in Spring 2020. Each edition includes academic research articles (3,000-5,000 words), practitioner essays (1,000 words), and book reviews (800 words max.). Each research article will be peer-reviewed, and accepted papers will be included in the print issue.

One special focus for this edition is broken families. This category could include ministering to and with kids of divorced parents, single moms or dads, co-parenting, incarcerated parents, grandparents as primary parents, and similar situations. This category could easily include broken spiritually where not all members are in church, kids whose parents are not in church, mom brings the family while dad stays home, or similar scenarios. Basically, this theme shows that family ministry, like the patriarchs of Hebrews 11, are not perfect but how God can still redeem and work through these imperfect situations.

Articles, essays, peer-reviews, and practitioner reflections beyond this theme are also welcomed.
